Notice of Race

- 1 Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2 Advertising**

Advertising will be restricted to Category A
- 3 Eligibility and Entry**
 - a) The regatta is open to all sailing dinghies.
 - b) Eligible boats may enter on the day, by completing an entry form in the Clubhouse and paying the required fee.
 - c) There will be a separate start for classes if there are 3 or more of any class
- 4 Classification**

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.
- 5 Fees**

Required fees are £10 per single hander, £15 per double hander
- 6 Schedule**
 - a) Registration will be open from 1030hrs on Saturday 17th September.
 - b) A briefing will be held at 1200hrs in the vicinity of the Clubhouse.
 - c) Three races are scheduled to take place.
 - d) Race one will start at 1300hrs .
- 7 Measurements**

Each dinghy should be in line with current class rules.
- 8 Sailing Instructions**

The sailing instructions will be available on registration.
- 9 Courses**

The courses to be sailed will be as depicted on the white board, which will be situated outside the clubhouse.
- 10 Scoring**
 - a) One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - b) A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. The event will be scored using the Portsmouth yardstick.
 - c) Races will be sailed under the average lap system.
- 11 Berthing**

Limited Boat parking will be available at the LMSC .
Car parking is available in the adjacent Forest Enterprise carparks. Charges may apply.
- 12 Prize giving**

Prize giving will be held at LMSC as soon as possible after racing on Saturday 17th September. Prizes will be presented to Fast and Slow handicap fleets.
- 13 Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
- 14 Insurance**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

DECLARATION / EXCLUSION AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and all other rules that govern this event.

A competitor is entirely responsible for his/her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility. It is for the competitor to decide whether he/she is fit to sail in the conditions in which it finds itself. By launching or going on the water, the competitor confirms that the boat is fit for those conditions and that its crew is competent to sail and compete in them.

The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £3m.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass anyone helping to run the race and the event, and included the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the competitors of their responsibilities.

Where helm (crew) is aged less than 18 this declaration is to be signed by a parent/guardian or other person acting in loco parentis and in the following form part of the declaration. Under law, this helm (crew) is my dependant, and I accept the **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY** in the Notice of Race which excludes my dependant's right to claim compensation in certain circumstances. I confirm that my dependant is competent to take part and that I am responsible for my dependant throughout the event. During the time my dependant is afloat I will be in or around Loch Morlich Sailing Club or I will inform the race officer in writing who is acting in loco parentis during my absence.

I agree to digital photographs being taken and distributed amongst the fleet as prizes and mementos.
